Brent Stephenson is a full-time birding guide and photographer. As co-owner of Wrybill Birding Tours, NZ along with Sav Saville, in 2003 they discovered the New Zealand Storm Petrel, a species believed extinct for more than 150 years. He currently holds the record for the most species seen in New Zealand in a calendar year. Since 2006 he has worked on small Expedition cruise ships in Antarctica, the Arctic and many places in between. He balances his time travelling the world with operating Eco-Vista: Photography & Research when in New Zealand. The highlight for 2013 was publishing his first book - Birds of New Zealand: A Photographic Guide.

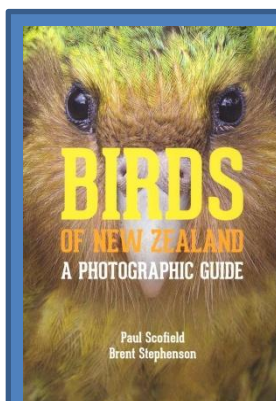
