Places to visit on National Meadows Day 2016



Saturday 2nd July

Kingcoed Meadows: Our beautiful reserve near Raglan in the heart of Monmouthshire, which we purchased this year following a successful fundraising effort. National charity Plantlife will be joining us and launching their new flower identification leaflet. Open 10am to 4.30pm, free admission

Glebe House Garden and Meadow: Joanna Kerr's lovely garden is part of the National Gardens Scheme. In 2012 Joanna and her neighbour Steve Roberts approached us for advice on creating a wildflower meadow in their fields, and this will be an opportunity to see their progress. Open 2pm to 5pm, £4 admission with all proceeds to Monmouthshire Meadows Group

Pentwyn Farm: Gwent Wildlife Trust is organising family activities at their flagship reserve in Penallt, with activities and crafts including meadow flower hunting and trails around the reserve. There will be refreshments available. Open 1pm to 4pm

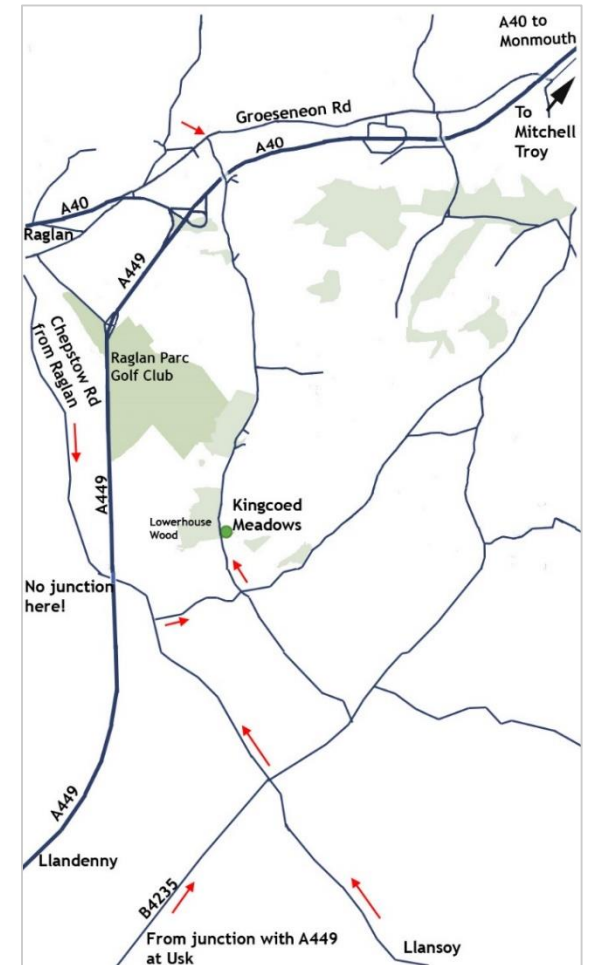
Directions

Kingcoed Meadows: From the Mitchell Troy-Raglan road, turn south near the tractor yard (at SO426085) before the road reaches the Raglan by-pass. Follow this minor road over the dual carriageway and then up a hill past two woods on your right. The meadows are found as you enter Kingcoed with the second wood on your right at SO427057. Satnav users can use post code NP15 1DS. (Map opposite)

Glebe House is at Llanvair Kilgeddin, Abergavenny NP7 9BE, midway between Abergavenny and Usk on the B4598. Travelling north from Usk take the minor road to the east at Llanvair Kilgeddin and it is the first property on the right at SO351078. Coming from the north, after crossing the A40 then the River Usk follow the minor road signed to the church and keep going past the church until you reach Glebe House on your left.

Pentwyn Farm, Penallt, near Monmouth NP25 4SE at map reference SO 523 094. In Penallt, take the small lane to the Inn at Penallt and follow signs for parking.
